- Consider the second and final reading of Ordinance 175-2024, which is an ordinance of the Town of Surgoinsville, Tennessee amending the 2023-2024 Fiscal Year Budget Budget Amendment #2. Recorder, Megan Gentry, provided a summary of this amendment. Vice-Mayor Jarnigan inquired

with Chief Hammonds for an update on the school flowmeter readings.
